

Merchant Compliance Notification
Interlink Eliminates Store and Forward Transactions

Effective July 1, 2010, Visa's Operating Rules will be updated to eliminate store and forward functionality associated with Interlink transactions to reduce risks associated with the compromise of track data as well as PIN information.

Store and forward is generally used when you are unable to dial out for an authorization and it enables you to store the transaction in your POS device until you are able to dial out to obtain an authorization.

After July 1, 2010, if your POS device is unable to dial out, you will need to ask for another form of payment.
